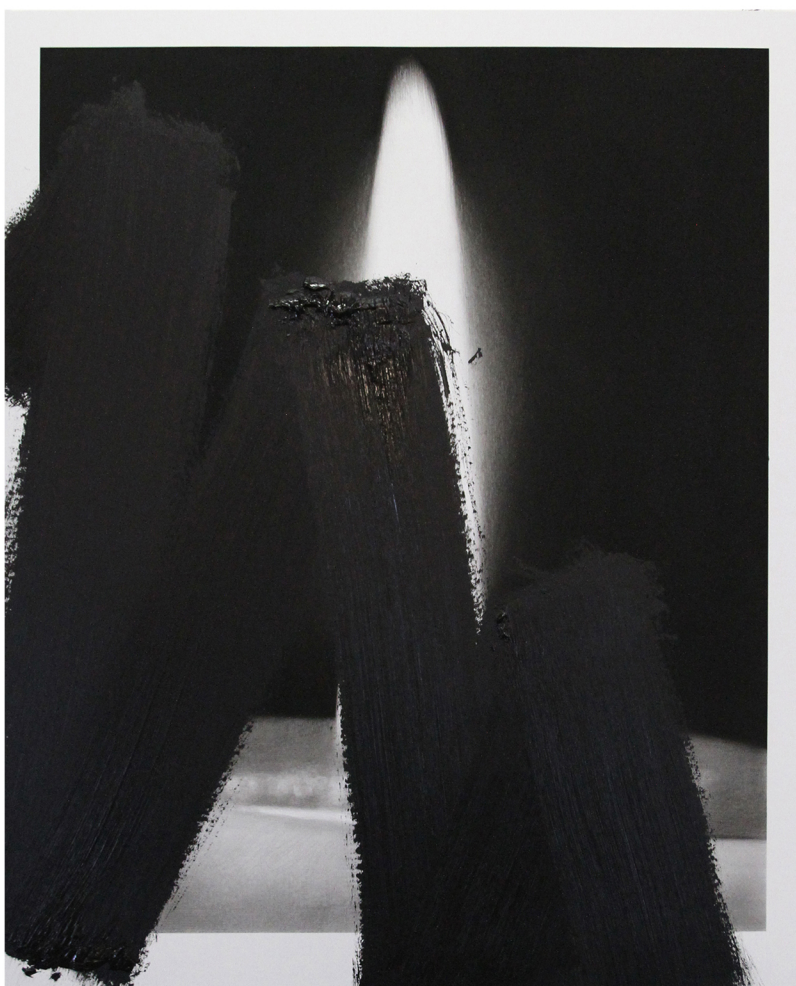


Allouche Gallery is proud to present Lou Ros featuring Valentin van der Meulen on Tuesday, May 15th from 6-9 pm.



Lou Ros is a 33 year old Parisian artist. The artist paints instinctually, inspired by the expressionists who fascinate him, “Through the colors, brush strokes, composition, background and rhythm of the painting, I attempt to create works which truly represent bodies in space without distortion. Without having a clear idea of the final result, I stop my work before it seems finished.” Ros finishes his work at the exact moment when the structure becomes clear. The viewer is drawn in by this form, and left to fill in the details of the image with his or her imagination. Lou Ros has been successfully exhibiting his paintings in galleries and various art fairs throughout Europe and the United States for ten years.

Similarly, 39 year old French artist Valentin van der Meulen’s work tells part of a story, allowing the observer to complete it with his or her mind. As per French philosopher and critic Eliette Abecassis explains, "Valentin van der Meulen's work in charcoal includes drawing as a process from its fabrication to its deconstruction in order to question the object that image is. To alter it to question its story and its legacy, placing the viewer in the center of his subjects.” Valentin van der Meulen has had solo exhibitions in France, Switzerland, Belgium and Germany. The artist has also participated in group shows throughout Europe and Canada.
